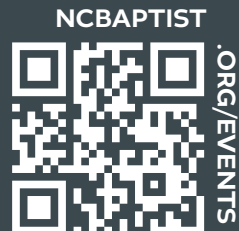


TRAINING DISCIPLES

Investing in children and students strengthens the church. Through BeDoTell, thousands of high school students participate in summer camps every year, with many committing to ministry. Go2 invites recent college graduates to give two years to live on mission through international missions, church planting and other ministry avenues.
